[C] Frosty the Snow Man was a [F] jolly happy [C] soul  
[C] With a corn-cob pipe and a [F] button [C] nose and  
[G7] two eyes made [C,G7] out of coal.  
[C] Frosty the Snow Man is a [F] fairy tale they [C] say  
[F F#dim] He was made of snow [C Am] but the children know  
[Dm7 G7 C] how he came to life one day.

[F] There must have [Em7; A7] been some magic in  
[Dm7] that old [G7; Cmaj7] silk hat they found,  
[G G#dim] For when they put it on his head  
[Am7] he began to dance around. [D7, G, G7]

[C] Frosty the Snow Man was alive [F F#dim] as he could be [C]  
[F] And the children say he could [Em7,A7] laugh and play  
[Dm7,G7,C] just the same as you and me.

[C] Frosty the Snow Man knew the [F] sun was hot that day, [C]  
[C] So he [F] said, "Let's run and we'll have some fun [C]  
[G7] now before I [C,G7] melt away."  
[C] Down to the village with a [F] broomstick in his hand, [C]  
Running [F,F#dim] here and there [C,Am] all around the square,  
[Dm7, G7,C] saying "Catch me if you can."

[F,Em7,A7] He led them down the streets of town  
[Dm7,G7,Cmaj7] right to the traffic cop,  
[G,G#dim] And he only paused a moment  
[Am7,D7] when he heard him holler, [G,G7] "Stop!"  
[C] For Frosty the Snow Man [F,F#dim,C] had to hurry on his way,  
[F] But he waved good-bye, [Em7,A7] saying, "Don't you cry;  
[Dm7,G7,C] I'll be back again someday."

[C] Thumpety thump thump,... Look at Frosty go.  
[G7] Thumpety thump thump,... Over the hills of snow. [C,]
